

Dear Engineering Students:

Registration for the spring semester (08S) will officially begin on Thursday, November 15th. All students will be assigned an appointment time in UDSIS to begin registering for classes based on class level and UD credit hours. This appointment time is now posted on your UDSIS Student Center page. You can access the registration system via a link in your UDSIS Student Center page called Registration & Drop/Add. This is a 3-step process with immediate feedback on your enrollment in the classes you select. Additionally, each engineering undergraduate student has been assigned a departmental advisor also found in UDSIS via the Student Center page. If you have a question regarding your advisor, please feel free to contact the Dean's Office at (302)831-8659.

In order to receive effective advisement and approval of your course selections, you must take the following steps:

1. Make an appointment to meet with your department advisor during the registration period as soon as possible, taking into account the conditions listed below.

_If you are on academic probation or special (academic) probation, I recommend that you meet with me prior to the appointment with your departmental advisor.

_If you plan to transfer into another major, you may make your advisement appointment with me instead of with your advisor.

2. Prepare for your advisement appointment by developing a tentative list of your next semester's courses. When selecting a Humanities or Social Science course, remember to reference the Breadth Requirements Handout you received at DelaWorld 101 (new student orientation). This document is available on line at http://www.engr.udel.edu/advise/breadth_07F.pdf as well as in paper form in the Dean's Office, 102 DuPont Hall.

3. Meet with your departmental advisor to discuss any issues and to finalize your choice of courses before completing the UDSIS online registration.
